### Contests Offered & Entries

The District Leadership & Skills Conference offers contests that require a qualification process for the State Leadership & Skills Conference based on the number of maximum entries allowed in the contest. Contest limits are based on spacing requirements, equipment needs, and a final decision made by the technical committee. The District Leadership & Skills Conference limits the number of competitors a chapter may enter in each contest. See the limits and entries section for more information. Additionally, a student competitor may only compete once in each of the contests offered at the conference. The following events are offered at the District Leadership & Skills Conference.

### Entries, Limits, & Waitlist

SkillsUSA Iowa limits the number of entries a school may enter based on capacity in operating contests. A chapter advisor may add students to the waitlist for the contest. If all open spots aren't filled at the close of registration, chapter advisors will be notified from the waitlist in order of submission, followed by the waitlist position.

### Online Objective Tests

Online objective tests will be taken during the District Leadership & Skills Conference at each local school. Objective Tests are taken via an online testing platform, TestMoz. Information about the online testing events will be sent to advisors after registration closes. Please ensure computers with internet access are available during this window for members to test. Testing at the district level is proctored and students must take the test with a proctor. A school official or unbiased educator serves as the test proctor. All tests are 50 questions and are timed with a 45-minute time limit in one sitting. The testing platform is set up with many fail safes to reduce cheating and uphold testing integrity. Please remind students of this and the penalties associated with cheating in competitive events. The online testing window is January 1 - 24, with hours of 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM CT during the testing window.

### Skills & Technical Demonstration

For the 2024-25 District Leadership & Skills Conference, the Welding (individual) contest will include a hands-on competition for high school only. There will be no technical or skills demonstration component for the Welding Fabrication, Carpentry, and Automotive Service Technology contests, which are both HS and PS.

Please review the <u>safety equipment and materials</u> that are REQUIRED to be supplied by the competitor.

### State Leadership & Skills Conference

Competitors who compete and qualify for the State Leadership & Skills Conference will be notified on January 31 with the awards announcement. Competitors who participated and qualified in tests may choose to compete in that specific event at the State Leadership & Skills Conference or may choose a different event.

All competitors will have to accept and reserve their seat to compete at the State Leadership & Skills Conference by Friday, February 14, 2025. An email with a link will be sent to the advisor and competitor to accept and reserve their spot for the contest.

### **Code of Conduct Agreement**

The SkillsUSA Iowa Leadership Conferences are designed to be an educational function and all plans are made with that objective. The Conferences represent SkillsUSA Iowa's most significant meetings of the year. SkillsUSA Iowa wants every person to have an enjoyable experience with every attention paid to safety and comfort. All participants will be expected to conduct themselves best representing the nation's greatest student organization. So that everyone may receive the maximum benefits from their participation, the "Code of Conduct," as established by the SkillsUSA Iowa Board, must be followed at all times. Note that attendance is not mandatory. By voluntarily participating, you agree to follow the official conference rules and regulations or forfeit your personal rights to participate. We are proud of our students and know that by signing this "Code of Conduct" you are simply reaffirming your dedication to be the best possible representative of your school and chapter.

- 1. I will, at all times, respect all public and private property, including the hotel or motel in which I am housed.
- 2. I will spend each night in the room of the hotel or motel to which I am assigned.
- I will strictly abide by the curfew established and shall respect the rights of others by being as quiet as possible after curfew.
- 4. I will not be in the sleeping room of the opposite sex.
- 5. I will not use alcoholic beverages. I will not use drugs unless I have been ordered to take certain prescription medications by a licensed physician. If I am required to take medication, I will, at all times, have the orders of the physician on my person.

### Violations and Penalties

I agree that if, for any reason, I am in violation of any of the rules of the conference I am attending, I may be brought before the appropriate discipline committee for an analysis of the violation. The participant's entire voting delegation could be unseated and the candidates or competitors from the participant's local chapter could be disqualified as well.
- 2. Violations of Items 7 through 12 will result in a warning and reprimand. Notification of the violation and the action taken will be sent to the participant's local school district administration and parents or guardians. Repeated violations of Items 7 through 12 may result in the participant being sent home at his/her own expense.

### Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that **SkillsUSA Iowa**, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records.
